MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Dear St. Agnes Parents,

Family Fitness Night is here! This evening from 6:30 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. our Parents' Club will be hosting this event. Organizations who volunteer their time each year prepare interactive booths to help us learn about healthy choices. There will be a food table with great snack items set up in the cafeteria and participative demonstrations throughout the building. This year, **families are asked to enter the main doors of the school** as we are not able to use the gym. Each **family** will be given a card listing the various booths that can be stamped as you visit the exhibits together... only one card per family. A free dress down day will be held April 27th for students (and teachers) who take the time to participate in the various booths. The prize table will be set up in the Kindergarten Hallway. I hope that many families can join us for this fun evening. We are grateful to the Parents' Club and to Parents' Club members, Jen Graves and Chrisa Leezer who have organized this evening.

Dates for the 2018-2019 School Year

Attached to today's Newsletter are the preliminary dates for next year's calendar. They include the beginning and ending of the 2018-2019 school year, vacation dates and days, other than holidays, when there is no school. A decision was made by the Faculty and School Board not to include a yearly calendar in the Parent/Student Handbook this coming year as each month there are always changes that need to be made in events, due to unforeseeable circumstances. You will receive the listing of events for the year in May (tentative calendar) and in the August packets but the calendar will be put out monthly.

Registration for the 2018-2019 School Year

Re-registration papers for the 2018-2019 school year should have been completed by this time. Families that we have not heard from should have received, yesterday, a second form to complete. Please take the time to complete your registration and return it if you have not done so. Please contact me for an appointment if there are concerns that you would like to discuss as we end one year and prepare for a new year.

Tuition Assistance

The applications for Tuition Assistance for the 2018-2019 school year can be completed on line. If you have already applied for SHG and listed St. Agnes children the applications will apply for both schools. The applications will be reviewed by Father Bob, Mrs. Cunningham and me and assistance assigned according to the funds we have available, the number requesting aide and the amount recommended by FACTS due to family need. St. Agnes School families who ask for financial aide, need to be aware that attending Mass and supporting our Church is a factor in considering financial aid.

Empower Illinois Scholarships

At a recent Principal Leadership meeting, we were asked by Bishop Paprocki to encourage our families to make use of the Empower Illinois Tax Credit Scholarship Program. Families could have their tuition and fees paid for the coming school year if you take the time to complete the application. The application and information about this program is available by going to the sight: <https://empowerillinois.org>. The documents you will need to collect to send along with your application include:

- + Copy of 2016 or 2017 federal tax return, 1099, W-2 or year-end pay stubs. (Do not mix years)
- + Verification of Illinois residence (utility bill, driver's license, etc.)
- + Documentation of student age (birth certificate, federal/state ID or passport)

- +Student's prior semester report card
- +Letter of acceptance or enrollment at an eligible school.

Families that are now receiving tuition assistance are strongly encouraged to apply. Funds are designated by regions. Whatever is not used for our region by June 1st will go into a general fund and can be used elsewhere.

Scholarship Applications

Eighth grade students received another application for a scholarship this week. It is the Jack and Peg Coleman scholarship for \$500.00. It is a service scholarship. These scholarships are due by Tuesday, May 1st.

Students in grades 6 & 7 received applications for the Ursuline Foundation Scholarship program that will award \$600 to a student in each Catholic School. These applications should have been received last week. They are due in the office by Wednesday, April 25th. They have to be presented to the committee by April 27th.

Tomorrow, April 20th, our kindergarteners will be participating in their annual Elegant Event. The children are very excited as they prepare to sport their best manners, dress-up clothing and many talents!
