Teaching Boundaries and Safety

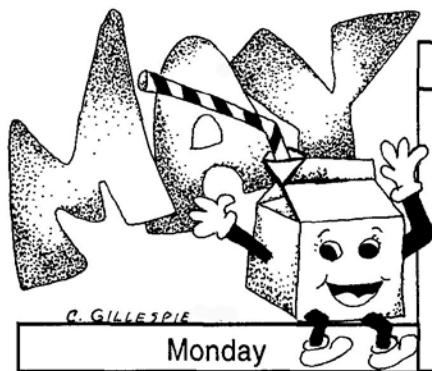

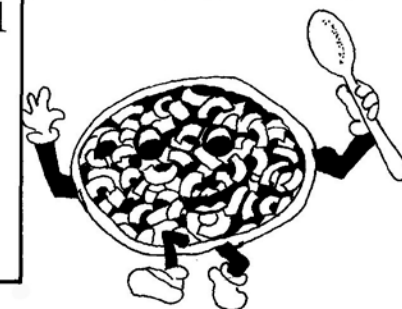
